Vision Statement

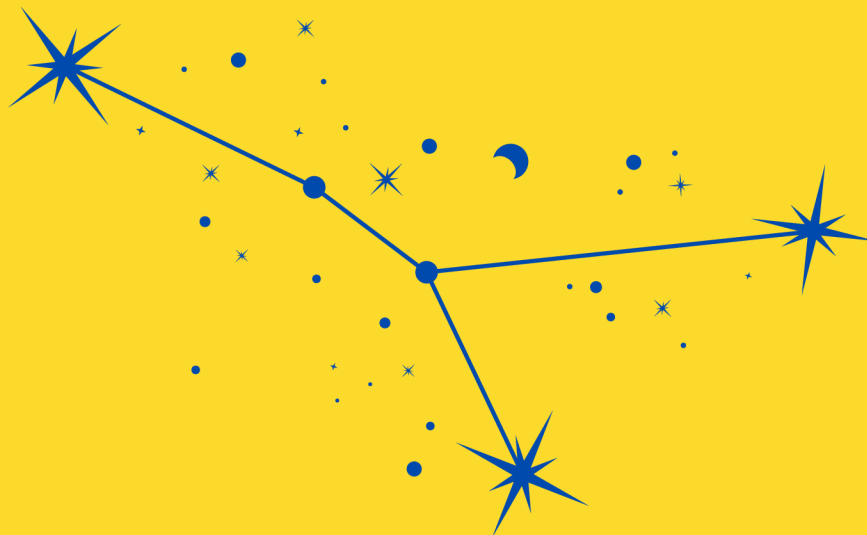

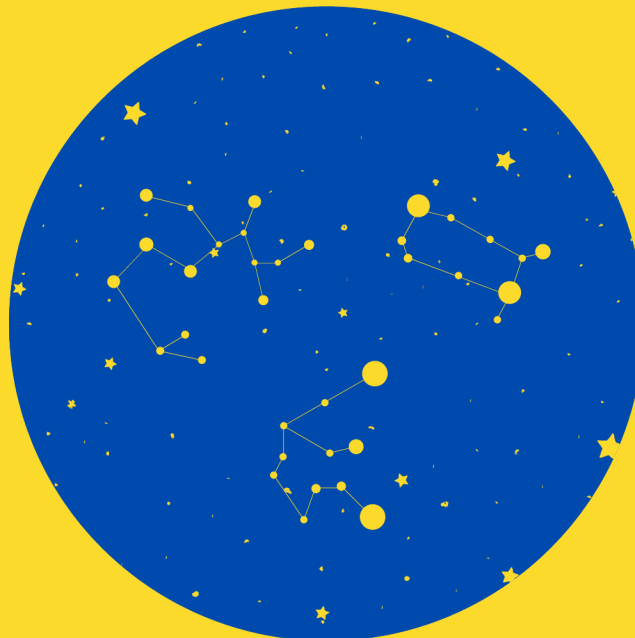

As a literary magazine we look for pieces that tackle philosophical themes. “Philosophically-themed” simply asks for the work to reflect on the deeper, ultimate questions of life, such as existence, human nature, morality, divinity, beauty, or even the origin of the universe. We publish works that pose or tackle these questions from non-Western perspectives. We accept fiction, creative non-fiction, poetry, and philosophical essays. We also accept works of art, including scans or photographs of physical mediums, digitally created art, as well as photography.

Nighthawk Star is a bi-annual publication, and we hope to produce more issues as we grow. We produce our magazine in-print and have digital downloads available online. Currently, our magazine is self-funded, and we are in search for sponsorship to assist the costs of running the magazine.

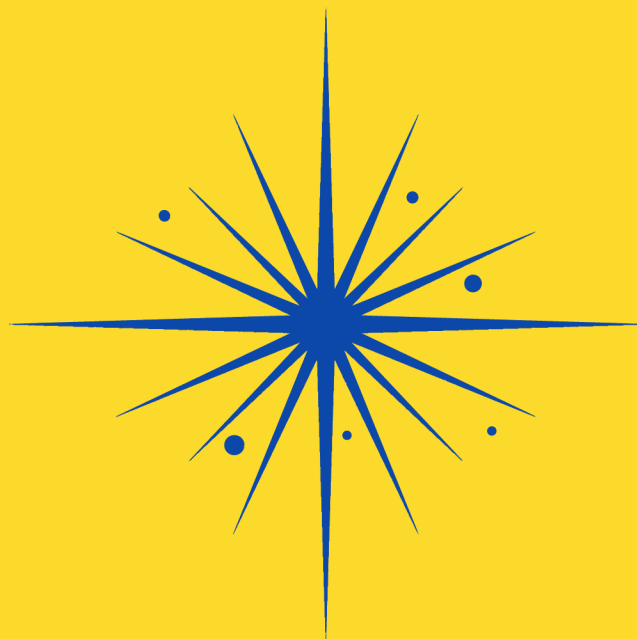
A new kind of philosophy magazine deserves a new kind of support.
